Registration for the Run for Autism fundraiser is now open and can be completed online via the following link:

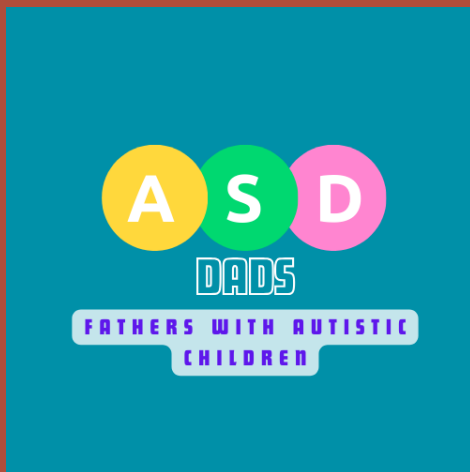
